- Reports to:** Stewards' Volunteer Programs Manager
- Time:** 4 hours per month
- Training:** A formal training course of 6 hours is required to become a Visitor Center Volunteer.
- Benefits:** Learn about the natural, cultural, and historical resources of the area, meet new and interesting people from all over the world while enriching and enhancing the experience of park visitor. Eligible for a District or a Statewide Volunteer in Parks Day Use Pass.
