Purpose:	To educate and interpret the Goat Rock Harbor Seal haulout to the visiting public and help protect baby seals fromhuman contact.
Duties:	Carry equipment to the haul out, greet park visitors and assist them in viewing the harbor seals from a safe distance.
Skills/ Qualifications:	This position requires good communication, people skills, and a willingness to learn about the natural historyof the harbor seals and the area.

Reports to:	Stewards' Volunteer Programs Manager
Time:	4 hour shift, once a month during haul out (March-September).
Training:	Training will be required and supplied by California State Parks on basic interpretation, marine mammals, and park rules and regulations.
Benefits:	Learn about the natural and cultural history of the RussianRiver area while contributing to the health and welfare of the harbor seals and the visiting public. Eligible for a District or a Statewide Volunteer in Parks Day Use Pass.
