- Title:** Seal Watch Shift Volunteer
- Purpose:** To educate and interpret the Goat Rock Harbor Seal haul out to the visiting public and help protect baby seals from human contact.
- Duties:** Carry equipment to the haul out, greet park visitors and assist them in viewing the harbor seals from a safe distance.
- Skills/
Qualifications:** This position requires good communication, people skills, and a willingness to learn about the natural history of the harbor seals and the area.
- Supervisor:** District Park and Rec Specialist Bill Maslach or designee
- Reports to:** Stewards' Volunteer Programs Manager
- Time:** 4 hour shift, once a month during haul out (March-September).
- Training:** Training will be required and supplied by California State Parks on basic interpretation, marine mammals, and park rules and regulations.
- Benefits:** Learn about the natural and cultural history of the Russian River area while contributing to the health and welfare of the harbor seals and the visiting public. Eligible for a District or a Statewide Volunteer in Parks Day Use Pass.
