<b>Title:</b>	<b>Whale Watch Shift Volunteer</b>
<b>Purpose:</b>	To educate and interpret Grey Whales and the Grey Whale Migration to the visiting public.
<b>Duties:</b>	To greet park visitors and assist them in viewing the Grey Whale Migration.
<b>Skills/ Qualifications:</b>	This position requires good communication, people skills, and a willingness to learn and share knowledge about Grey Whale Migration.
<b>Supervisor:</b>	District Park and Rec Specialist Bill Maslach or designee
<b>Reports to:</b>	Stewards' Volunteer Programs Manager
<b>Time:</b>	After initial training period, a minimum of 4 hours per month during the migration period (January - May).
<b>Training:</b>	Training will be required and supplied by California State Parks on basic interpretation, marine mammals, and park rules and regulations.
<b>Benefits:</b>	Learn about the natural history of Grey Whales and their migration and other aspects of the natural environment. Eligible for a District or a Statewide Volunteer in ParksDay Use Pass.
