Volunteer
- Purpose:** To promote awareness and understanding of the Willow Creek Watershed for students in 6-12th grades.
- Duties:** Work with middle school and high school students in the classroom and in the field to assist them in gaining an understanding of the components of a healthy watershed. Lead and assist in the development of watershed monitoring activities and field studies in the Willow Creek Watershed. Provide feedback to State Parks' staff on classroom and field activities.
- Skills/
Qualifications:** This position requires good communication skills and the ability to work with students and demonstrate water quality monitoring tests and activities, and provide guidance and instruction on specific tests. This position will require communication with school personnel, State Parks' personnel, other volunteers, and program developer.
- Supervisor:** District Park and Rec Specialist Bill Maslach or designee
- Reports to:** Stewards' Volunteer Programs Manager
- Time:** Dates and hours to be arranged. Available for classroom and field visits during the school year and school hours: September - June.
- Training:** Attend Watershed Training provided by State Parks and demonstrate competence in leading classroom/field activities.
- Benefits:** Learn about the natural and cultural history of the Russian River area and assist in restoring and preserving the Willow Creek Watershed. Eligible for a District or a Statewide Volunteer in Parks Day Use Pass.
